14. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years to be driven in any class.
15. All entrants must have their own Third Party insurance.
16. The Society reserve the right to amalgamate classes where there are insufficient entries.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL

1. The committee disclaims all responsibility for any accident to or loss by any person or animal at the show. No claim will be entertained for anything that may happen to exhibitors, their employees or those who accompany them, their property, exhibits or goods.
2. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall indemnify the Society and/or any official or guest of the Society against any claim arising from any accident and/or occurrence in which the exhibitor or his exhibit are involved.
3. All horses must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor for one month prior to the closing date for entries.
4. The Society will adhere as closely as possible to the published schedule and programme but reserve the right in their absolute discretion to put forward or alter any class without notice if found expedient to do so and the right to refuse any entry and to cancel any class if less than three entries or otherwise without necessarily giving a reason.
5. Only officials appointed by the Society and exhibitors currently showing in a class shall be permitted to enter the Show Ring
6. Prize Money will be awarded according to the following scale of forward entries:-
1, 2 or 3 entries 1, 2 or 3 prizes respectively, rosettes and prize cards to 4th place
Prize Money may be withheld, or having been awarded may be reclaimed, if an exhibit is found subsequently not to be as represented.
7. It should be noted that cup winners are responsible for having trophies engraved and if this is not done by them the Society cannot undertake to keep the cups up-to-date
8. All protests must be made in writing stating the grounds of objection and must be lodged with the Secretary within one hour from the time the prize was awarded, together with a deposit of £10 which will then be forfeit to the funds of the Society unless the protest is upheld.
9. All disputes shall be settled by committee which the society has appointed or by any referee whom that committee may appoint and such decision shall be final.
10. All animals entered for special prizes or cups must be entered in their appropriate class.

360 Pleasure Driving (Open to horses, ponies, donkeys and mules. A single, pair or tandem driven to a vehicle, to include exercise vehicles, capable of seating 2 or more persons.)

To be judged: 15% vehicle suitability, fit and cleanliness, carrying appropriate spares; 15% harness suitability (leather or man-made), fit and cleanliness; 70% driver/groom appropriately dressed, condition, soundness and fitness of animal/s, way of going and overall suitability of a pleasure drive.

Competitors may, for example, be required to drive and halt between two pairs of cones and/or given other specific movements to execute in their show.

Dress for Pleasure

Driving classes would be less formal than for a showing class.

Traditional or non-traditional vehicles are permitted, and for the purposes of this class they will be judged on equal merit.

Pneumatic tyres, specifically designed for carriages (i.e. not car tyres) are allowed. Lamps need not be carried.

361 Open Private Driving (class may be divided if enough forward)

Horse or pony driven to a traditional or traditional type vehicle.

A traditional vehicle means a vehicle of traditional profile and identifiable type to resemble the design of a carriage built prior to the First World War. The vehicle may be made from modern materials but must have traditional style springing and carriage lamps.

Pneumatic tyres vehicles, trade turnouts and show wagons are not eligible.

This class is a qualifier for the 2016 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships at Driving Addington on 24th September. The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following Type-Section/s, disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class, will qualify for the 2016 Semi-Finals at Driving Addington. a - Single hackney-type - over 13.2hh

f - Single purebred Registered Welsh Cob - Section D

This is a Victoria Food Company open Private Driving Championship qualifier. The Champion will qualify for the Grand Final to be held on Sunday 11th September 2016, at the Kings Sedgemoor Equestrian Centre, Greylake, Nr Bridgwater. In the event that the Champion has already qualified then the Reserve Champion to qualify. If the reserve has also qualified, the rosette to be awarded back to the Champion. Once qualified, the horse, whip and vehicle may not be changed.
